**I will respect the authority of all central figures,** including parents, group leaders, lecturers, and the camp director. Joy is created by unity centered on a higher purpose.

**I will respect the happiness and safety of others** and not play pranks or play with knives at camp. I understand that fireworks and firecrackers are illegal and I will not bring them. In addition, I will not bring any toy guns that launch projectiles. Stink bombs do not contribute joy to others, and I will not bring them.

**I will respect God's Creation.** Camp Shehaqua is part of the wilderness and should be left that way. I will leave the camp in the same or better state than I found it. I will keep camp clean by putting all my garbage in the appropriate place and picking up any garbage I see.
